RESIDENCY VERIFICATION REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

All documents must be issued within the last 30 days and show parent/guardian name and address.

You must provide a valid State ID or Driver's License or Passport, one (1) document from Category A and two (2) documents from Category B. All documents must be in hand in order to start the registration process.

No Exceptions. Please Be Prepared with all Documents.

Category A - One (1) document

- Real estate tax bill
- Mortgage statement
- Signed lease & payment receipt for the current month (Only for Willow Springs Residents)
- Residency/Attestation for Sterling Estates Residents Only (The Sterling Estates office will provide you with this approved form. Form must include parent/guardian name and student name.)

Category B - Two (2) documents

- Gas bill
- Electric bill
- Current Water/Sewer bill
- Cable Bill
- Car Loan Statement
- Credit Card Statement
- Bank Statement
- City Sticker Receipt

Please contact the registration staff if you are having trouble collecting all three documents. The district may require a home visit and/or additional documentation to verify residency.

•Student registration fee is \$75.00 per child. Students who register on July 13 and July 14 will receive a \$20.00 discount per student. Any student(s) registering on July 15th and future dates must pay the full \$75.00 registration fee.

•8th Grade student graduation fee will be \$75.00. Parents will be notified if this changes.

Dear Parents and Families,

Another school year has come to an end. And, what a year it has been! From the virtual Kick-Off event in August, learning how to connect to Zoom, and using the Seesaw and Google Classroom apps, we all quickly learned how to adapt to online learning. Then in January, the students returned to school wearing masks, socially distanced at all times, and had to quarantine when there was illness or exposure. Registration for the 2021-22 school year begins in July! For returning families, the Teacherease portal opens on July 6th. In-person registration is scheduled for July 13 and 14 at Willow, by appointment only. The first day for students is August 18th, so finish the registration process early.

We have some staff news! After 33 years, Margaret Schomburg is retiring! She began her educational career teaching 1st grade at a Catholic school, and transferred to Willow to become the 3rd grade teacher. Over the years, Ms. Schomburg was instrumental in learning new technology as the students transitioned from paper to computer instruction. In addition to 3rd grade, Ms. Schomburg coached volleyball, taught summer school, and ran after school computer classes. Willow is going to miss her!

Congratulations to Ms. Jill Craig on her upcoming retirement! Ms. Craig has taught math at the junior high level for 17 years. In addition to her math assignment, Ms. Craig has been Student Council advisor and 8th grade sponsor. Before Willow, Ms. Craig taught in Chicago Public Schools and Butler School District in Oak Brook.

Lastly, Ms. Teresa Malawski from the lunchroom is also retiring. The students know Ms. Malawski as "Ms. Teresa". She has been serving breakfasts, lunches, and monitoring the playground at recess for 18 years! She said she loved being outside with the kids!

School is over for the year, and we realize many of you have questions about the upcoming year! While waiting for guidelines from ISBE, Willow is planning on returning to full day instruction. We are hoping things will feel much more "normal" in August. Ms. Alexandra Oreluk will hold the principal position, and she is already hard at work preparing for the new school year.

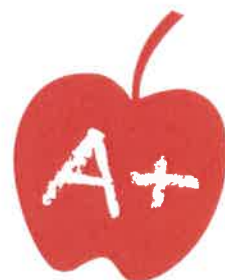
