## RESIDENCY VERIFICATION REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

All documents must be issued within the last 30 days and show parent/guardian name and address.

You must provide a valid State ID or Driver's License or Passport, one (1) document from Category A and two (2) documents from Category B. All documents must be in hand in order to start the registration process.

**No Exceptions. Please Be Prepared with all Documents.**

### Category A - One (1) document

- Real estate tax bill
- Mortgage statement
- Signed lease & payment receipt for the current month (Only for Willow Springs Residents)
- Residency/Attestation for Sterling Estates Residents Only (The Sterling Estates office will provide you with this approved form. Form must include parent/guardian name and student name.

Please contact the registration staff if you are having trouble collecting all three documents. The district may require a home visit and/or additional documentation to verify residency.

•Student registration fee is \$75.00 per child. Students who register on July 13 and July 14 will receive a \$20.00 discount per student. Any student(s) registering on July 15th and future dates must pay the full \$75.00 registration fee.

•8th Grade student graduation fee will be \$75.00. Parents will be notified if this changes.
