Dear Parents/Guardians:

There have been some reported cases of streptococcal infections in the building. We are giving you this information so that you can do your part in controlling the spread of this disease and protecting the health of your child. Please observe your child carefully; if he presents symptoms of illness, keep him at home and consult your physician.

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS:

The signs of strep are sudden onset of fever with sore throat, pain on swallowing, and tender glands in the neck. Diagnosis is by throat culture.

A streptococcal infection with a rash is called "scarlet fever". In such cases, the above signs are followed in a day or two by a bright red rash with pin-point dots. The presence or absence of rash does not make a difference in treatment, length of illness or chance of complications.

INCUBATION PERIOD:

Short, usually one to four days after exposure.

MODE OF TRANSMISSION:

Nearly always directly from person to person; occasionally, indirectly through articles freshly soiled by discharge of the patient,

CONTROL OF CASE:

The child will stay home for 24 hours after antibiotic therapy has begun. After that the child may return to school if he is well.

Antibiotics should be continued for a full 10 days (even if the child is well) so as to prevent complications such as rheumatic fever.
