Math



K-5 Art

Kindergarten: KL students are making Winter Cardinals! They created a sky paper by printing marker coloring off of aluminum foil! We are finishing making paper cardinals using basic shapes.

1st Grade: Students in 1T are working on a "Happy Penguin" project. We learned about how to show movement in art by drawing spiral lines and painting a cold background. We will be making penguins out of paper and add details like scarves and hats!

2nd Grade: Students in 2M are working on a project called "Under the Leaves". We made a forest scene and cut and glued leaves that you can 'peek" under to see who is hiding on the forest floor!

3rd Grade: Students in 3C are working on a project called "Over and Under the Snow". We read a book and learned about what different animals do in winter. We are making a layered painting showing underground hibernating animals, and animals that stay awake and brave the cold and snowy winter!

4th Grade: Students in 4B started a paper project called "Cozy Animals". We talked about symmetry and cut our animals out on folded paper to make them symmetrical. We will add "pop-out" hands and add paper details to make our animals look cozy and warm!

5th grade: Students do not have art for this quarter rotation.













Ms. Baricovich S.I. K-2 & 4th Grade Classes with ClearMath

Kindergarten-We are continuing Topic 4-Sorting objects according to their attributes. We are counting objects in groups, then comparing and ordering each group.

1st Grade-We are continuing Topic 4-Exploring grouping by tens and ones through the use of connecting cubes, working with 2 digit numbers on the number line and locating multiples of 10, and adding and subtracting multiples of 10 with 2 digit numbers.

2nd Grade-We are continuing Topic 2, which focuses on place value through 999. We are using place value cubes to model numbers through 999 and beginning regrouping.

4th Grade-We are starting Topic 4–Students extend their work with place value to learn about tenths and hundredth in decimal notation. They will model decimal quantities using base–10 blocks and 10-by-10 grids, recognize the connection between decimals and fractions. Students will realize that the tenths and hundredths places have the same meaning as fractions with denominators of 10 and 100, respectively.
